What is an Energy Audit?

An Energy Audit is an assessment of the energy consumed by your home. The audit identifies ways to decrease energy consumption and costs and to increase energy efficiency.

What is RESNET?

RESNET is the Residential Energy Services Network, the American Building Performance Rating System. RESNET is a non-profit industry membership corporation that makes national standards for building energy efficiency rating systems and certifies individuals as Raters.

What is a RESNET Certified Rater?

A certified RESNET Rater is an individual who has the knowledge base and skill set defined by RESNET, has performed 5 ratings under the supervision of a Certified Rater, passed a national online test, and then becomes certified by a RESNET Rating Provider.
